And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.



# A Month For Love VS A Lifetime Of Love

St Valentine's Day falls in February and the stores are filled with flowers, cards, candy and an abundance of reminders that if there is someone in our live we love, show it!

Of course the stores have a vested interest in commercializing this occasion. It's all about the money. And vet, I don't mind so much as I think about my darling wife who has stuck with me through the thick and thin of life's traumas, and ministry's heartaches, and declining health. It also reminds me of my lovely daughters and granddaughters. It even makes me reflect on all those lovely people who supported my ministry with their attendance, their finances, their cards and letters of encouragement, and their personal visits, hugs, and warm handshakes.

Now I can't speak for Jesus on the commercialization of loving others but he does speak to us about loving others. In Matthew 5:46 he says, "For if you love those who love you, what reward have you?"And he follows that statement by pointing to what was considered to be the worst sinners of his day. He says, "Do not even the tax collectors do the same?"

Earlier in this same chapter he says, "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven (Matthew 5:43-47, NKJV)" I wonder if Jesus were with us in person today as we shopped for cards, flowers, candy and the like for those we love if he would have us consider sending something nice to those who hate us, who want us to fail, who say lies about us and plot our demise?

How exactly do we "love our enemies?" He says we are to greet them but I believe he wants more than that. I believe he wants us to change our way of thinking. He wants us to change our way of loving so that we don't pick and choose who we will care about. He wants us to care about everybody, especially those who are our enemies!

Now I don't say any of these things on my own authority because I don't have any authority. I don't assert my opinion on the matter because my opinion is of no consequence. However, I do quote Jesus because his authority is absolute and his opinion does count for everything. He tells us how his Father operates in Matthew 5 as well when he says, "for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust."

He also demonstrated his depth of commitment to this principle on the cross, "Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do (Luke 23:34a, NKJV)." He said this about those who orchestrated his crucifixion!

Paul tells us in Romans 5:8-11 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. <sup>9</sup> Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. <sup>10</sup> For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. <sup>11</sup> And not only *that*, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation (NKJV)."

If you and I are now believers and friends of Christ Jesus, we must also understand that we were once his enemies. We must understand that he loved us first as we are told in 1 John 4:18-20, There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love. We love Him because He first loved us. If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen (NKJV)?"

February may be the month we focus on love and that may not be all bad. However, Christ Jesus wants us to focus on a life of love, and that my dear readers, is all good!

For me - being a highly opinionated, vocal, and type A personality this means that I have irritated, offended, and/or really ticked some folks off. I know this because they have told me so in word and deed. It is much easier to dismiss the opinion of these folks, ignore their anger, and avoid their company than it is to love them. And yet, as a Christian, I - and all other true followers of Christ Jesus, are called not to do the easy thing but rather to do the hard task of loving those who don't love us.

Matthew concludes chapter 5 with these words from Jesus. "Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect (NKJV)."

I believe with all my heart, mind, and soul that Jesus' mission, in part, was to save us by perfecting us in love. Let's cooperate with him and his desire for us by truly loving one another. Let's lay down our boxing gloves and put on the mantle of Christ Jesus.

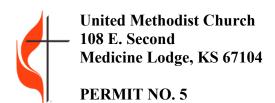
